

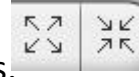
### 3) Importing New Sprites and Speaking/Thinking

1) Open a new Scratch document. Using the scissors, delete the cat sprite.

- Select two sprites from the folder.



- Adjust sprite sizes using grow and shrink buttons.




2) Add in a background (setting) for your two sprites.



3) Now that you have two new sprites in the stage area, create a conversation between the two new sprites using the thinking and/or speaking blocks with **time** attached.



- Use  in between your speaking blocks to time your script properly (change the number of seconds in the wait block to match how long a sprite speaks for)

**\*Make sure your video is school appropriate\***

#### EXTRA CHALLENGE

Create a second comic strip using two new sprites, make sure you have at least one block from each of the following categories:

MOTION (forward, backward, turning)

LOOKS (speaking/thinking, changing effects)

CONTROL (wait, green flag, repeating)

ADD IN A BACKGROUND
